If you would like to indulge your sense of adventure you can try camel trekking, horse riding, surfing, quad biking, an Essaouira souk visit and cookery lessons.

# Trip Overview

This outstanding seven-night family activity holiday will show you Morocco from all angles. Going everywhere from quiet Berber villages to buzzing city souks, you and the children will have the opportunity to try out stupendous activities on both sand and sea. As well as this, you'll sample the local culture and cuisine along the way!

This family holiday begins in lively Marrakech. During your 3 nights here, you and your family will stay just outside the busy city areas in the tranquility of Oasis Lodges. If you prefer to stay closer to the action, we can arrange alternative accommodation in the old town of Marrakech. This option will suit travellers keen to soak up as much Moroccan atmosphere as possible, particularly couples and families with older children.

You'll take a tour of the astonishing souks and experience an array of sights, scents and sounds as well as an insight into the people here. Then, you'll take a trip to the aweinspiring Atlas Mountains, a must-see when in Morocco.

The next part of your holiday transports you to the Agafay Desert which promises to be a truly magical experience. You'll stay at either the Inara camp offering nine tents with



panoramic views, an ultimate level of comfort and are fitted with electricity outlets or an equally enchanting bivouac in Scarabeo Camp which are all adorned with uniquely sourced pieces, interesting artefacts and locally crafted artwork.

Following your stay in the desert, your holiday takes you close to the beautiful port city of Essaouira. You will stay in a luxurious villa at the Rebali Riads hotel, a marvellous place with a traditional Moroccan design.

Here you will have the opportunity to sit down, discuss and arrange your own itinerary with the attentive and helpful staff. You can set your own pace and add in your choice of activities (payable locally). You can choose from a range of cultural, gastronomic and adventurous options.

In your free time, you will definitely want to enjoy the hotel's on-site facilities. Unwind in a traditional hammam steam room, splash about in the pool, or challenge each other to a spot of tennis.

DAY

ARRIVAL AND WELCOME

Upon arrival in Marrakech, your transfer vehicle will take you to your accommodation at Oasis Lodges, approximately 10 minutes away.

Once you have checked in, you and your family can relax in the idyllic surroundings of the Oasis Lodges - why not have dinner at their restaurant or you can ask them to recommend a local restaurant to try?

Fill up at breakfast in preparation for a lovely excursion exploring the Atlas Mountains.

A two-hour transfer will take you to your starting point, the village of Imlil, from where you will spend the day trekking in this scenic region with a mountain guide.

Mount Toubkal, the highest peak in the Atlas Mountains, looms in the background as you take to the trail. You will walk through small hamlets and woods filled with walnut trees, weaving up to higher ground along the mountain track.



The views are incredible and this is a marvellous way to show off the natural side of Morocco, which is easily missed when just sticking to popular urban attractions.

There will be the chance to visit at least one village in the area for a sense of life in these rural parts of the country, you will also enjoy lunch at a local restaurant. The trip can be tailored to the needs and abilities of the group and includes lunch.

You will return to Oasis Lodges in the late afternoon.

### Spend a night in The Enchanting Marrakech Medina

If you would like to extend your trip and spend a night or two in the ancient heart of this vibrant city, please speak to one of our Travel Experts about your requirements and we will come back with the perfect riad for you! Many riads also have rooftop terraces with stunning views of the city. These are great places to relax and enjoy the

sunset or people-watch.

The medina itself is a maze of narrow streets and alleyways, and it is easy to get lost. However, this is part of the charm of the medina and that extends to your arrival. Your transfer will drop you and your luggage off at the gates of the medina. One of the knowledgeable porters will put your luggage on their trolley and will take you straight to your riad. It is useful to pay attention to the route as it will help you get your bearings but your hosts will also be able to provide you with maps and directions once you are checked in.

There is a non-licensed restaurant on-site and plenty of other options within walking distance of the property. If you'd like to venture into the enchanting Medina or Jemaa el-Fnaa, there is a complimentary shuttle bus service available.

#### 2 Bedroom Lodge

Offering luxury and comfort, the lodges comprise of two double or twin rooms, separate shower and toilet. teh living room is adorned with a fireplace and terrace with a view of the private garden. Equipped with a Smart TV, mini bar, espresso coffee machine, tea service, safe and hammock, a comfortable stay is beckoning. These lodges benefit from the following services: breakfast, entrance to the OASIRIA Park, daily bottle of water and a basket of seasonal fruit on the day of your arrival.

Inara or Scarabeo Camp (Nights: 4)







Enjoy a night under a star-studded sky in the Agafay Desert. You will spend an evening at either the Inara or Scarabeo Camp. Both sites offer a luxurious and intimate camping experience set against the breathtaking backdrop of the canyons of the majestic Marrakech desert of Agafay.

Your private glamping suite consists of a metal structure fixed on a wooden terrace and three layers of fabric for ultimate comfort.

#### Scarabeo Camp Glamping Suites

The Glamping suites have the following facilities:

- En-suite facilities housing western toilets and Berber shower facilities with one hot and one cold bucket of water
- Traditional black soap

Rebali Riads (Nights: 5-7)



White walls and bright interiors meet gleaming swimming pools and scattered greenery in this hotel, which takes after a 'riad', or traditional Moroccan house. 'Paradise' might be a better word because it's a place of sun-soaked luxury. There are seven private villas, each with fully-furnished kitchens, dining courtyards, and personal gardens. Four of these are larger and come with their own pool, while the three smaller buildings share two interconnected pools between them. All have inviting roof terraces with all-round views of sand, sea and countryside. The main hotel has hammam and spa facilities, a tennis court, and a service kitchen with a full-time chef.

### Hotel facilities



- With a full-time chef available on request, you can look forward to gorgeous Moroccan specialities and European favourites served fresh in the dining area or by the pool
- Challenge the kids on the tennis court or try out a game of boules in the large shared garden. There's also a table tennis set and plenty of board games to keep the family entertained
- Get fully refreshed in the Moroccan hammam steam room or go for a continental spa treatment. There is also a small gift shop in the reception building
- Read up on your next activity or look for something to book with the free Wi-Fi, which is available in reception and at certain hotspots around the riads

### Room type

Each of the seven riads is uniquely designed, based around a dining courtyard area which is covered with a remote-controlled sliding glass roof. Each also has a fully decked-out kitchen and a roof terrace with 360° views of the surroundings.

**Dar Azreq:** This riad has two bedrooms with ensuite bathrooms, each containing two basins. The bathroom attached to the main bedroom has a marble-lined bath and twin showers. As well as a personal roof terrace, Dar Azreq has a garden with a gated entrance to the shared pool area.

**Dar Etoile:** This has one master bedroom and a snug room which can be converted into a bedroom. The bathroom comes with twin showers and basins and a bath topped with marble. There is also a downstairs toilet. It also has a kitchen, dining courtyard, and sitting room with a fireplace. In addition, Dar Etoile has a private roof terrace and garden with a gated entrance to the shared pool area.

**Dar Jeseli:** This two-bedroom riad has two ensuite bathrooms with twin basins; the main bedroom bathroom has double showers and a marble-lined bath. There is a private roof terrace and a garden with a gated entrance to the shared pool area.

**Dar Mevada:** This riad has three bedrooms – one is a master suite with a four-poster bed and ensuite bathroom; the other two share one bathroom which contains a marble-lined bath and a shower. There is a kitchen and dining courtyard, bar area, and sitting room. Outside there is a private pool, as well as a private roof terrace.

**Riad Sila:** This riad has three suites, each having its own balcony and bathroom with a shower, marble-topped bath, and twin basins. In the master suite, there is a four-poster bed and an open-plan bathroom. Downstairs is a grand, high-ceilinged sitting room; this sits next to a snug room which can be converted into a fourth bedroom. The snug room has an open fire and access to the downstairs shower room. Riad Sila has its own pool and a private roof terrace.

**Riad Valmar:** The largest of the riads, this is based around three courtyards: one with a sliding glass roof and dining area; another with orange trees, a water fountain, and open space; and the last meeting the three sides of the swimming pool. The courtyards link up with the sitting room and cinema room. Upstairs are four suites, each with private terraces and ensuite bathrooms – containing twin basins and walk-in showers. Two are master



suites containing four-poster beds, marble-topped baths, and twin showers. The cinema room can be converted into a fifth bedroom and has access to the downstairs shower room.

**Dar Jamila:** This three-bedroom riad is a few steps away from the main hotel building, slightly closer to the sea. The riad has an open-plan living room with a kitchen, breakfast bar, fireplace, TV and dining table. Outside there is a large terrace and private pool, as well as a private roof terrace with views of the sea. The master bedroom has a four-poster bed with an en-suite bathroom, a walk-in shower and twin basins. The second bedroom has a king-size bed and the third has two twin beds. Both rooms have en-suite bathrooms with walk-in showers and twin basins.
