With its picturesque landscape and seascapes, abundance of wildlife and a wealth of family-friendly activities on offer, the Azores promise to leave the whole family in awe, with something for everyone. Discover The Azores natural wonders and take the time to relax in this peaceful paradise.

DAY 1

ARRIVAL AND WELCOME

Upon arrival at João Paulo II Airport, the driver of your transfer vehicle will be waiting to take you and your family to your hotel which is approximately 10 minutes away, ready for check in.

Tonight is kept free to allow you free time to settle into Ponta Delgada and to charge up for the adventures ahead.

Today, after breakfast, you will have the opportunity to see the fascinating marine life of the Azores as you set sail on a catamaran!

During the whale and dolphin watching tour, be sure to keep your eyes peeled for some of the 25 cetacean species found in the Azores. Though there are no guarantees, whales and dolphins are regularly seen during these half-day tours.

As well majestic cetaceans, you'll be in with a chance of spotting turtles, seabirds and other marine life. Before you head out on your Atlantic adventure, a marine biologist will provide a family-friendly briefing, making the experience educational and entertaining.

You'll all get to learn about the different cetacean species, safety measures aboard, how to respect the animals as well as some historical facts.

It's a brilliant trip for the whole family. Once you're back on land, your afternoon is free to spend as you wish.

Included Meals: Breakfast



Today is all about exploring the captivating volcanic landscapes of the Azores.

First, you will visit Gorreana Tea Estates, one of Europe's oldest remaining tea plantations.

Visit the growing areas and see the machinery in operation with your informative and



friendly guide. It's fascinating to learn about the process of this much-loved refreshment, which you will, of course, get to sample here.

Second stop is Caldeiras das Furnas where you can see the earths volcanic activity at work. Here, you'll witness fumaroles and mineral springs and can even try the water from each spring to see how taste varies because of the different minerals present.

At lunch, you have the chance to try the local dish of Cozido das Furnas. This is the classic Portuguese 'cozido' which is a stew of slow-cooked meats and vegetables but with an Azorean twist. Here, the locals really make use of the geothermal activity and cook this delicious meal using the natural steam from the ground!

Following lunch, it's time to explore the remarkable Terra Nostra Botanical Gardens. Filled with a variety of plant life, this is an interesting visit which includes the fantastic opportunity for the family to soak in the iron-rich waters of a geothermal pool. The waters have a soothing temperature of around 35°C to 40°C and the minerals present will leave you feeling deeply relaxed. (Please take old swimming costumes as the mineral water can stain them a light brown colour).

Included Meals: Breakfast, Lunch



After fuelling up on breakfast, the whole family have an adventurous day ahead exploring the west side of São Miguel in a jeep.

On the way, you will all stop at spectacular viewpoints to enjoy this beautiful landscape. One of the stops will be at the Vista do Rei where you can enjoy the views of the 'Lagoon of Seven Cities' that consists of a twin lake formed in the crater of a dormant volcano, one is coloured blue and the other is green!

After arriving at the lake, you can explore the surroundings on an exciting 10km bike ride. The trail is largely flat, with only 10 minutes of uphill peddling which means it can be enjoyed by the whole family. There is an option to do a tougher route if you're feeling up to the challenge!

Theres also the chance to try kayaking across the lake (family race is optional!)

A picnic lunch is included today.

Back at the hotel, you'll have a free evening to spend your final night in Ponta Delgada. You could head out and sample more of the local cuisine. We'd strongly recommend trying Azorean tapas... black pudding with pineapple might surprise a few people. Especially the kids!

With easy access to the airport and within walking distance of shopping, restaurants and bars, this hotel is the perfect combination of convenience and style.
