Trip Overview

Jeris encompasses the Lappish idyll; cosy winter cottages, log fires, a beautiful lakeside setting, winter forests and a range of exceptional family activities. It's the ideal location in which to combine comfort, activities and a truly memorable Christmas.

Your family will meet with reindeer, enjoy dog sledding, travel by snowmobile and explore using both snowshoes and cross-country skis. You will dine around campfires and eat in a traditional kota. Festive fun is sprinkled throughout with cookie baking, toasting marshmallows and magical wishing trees all part of your stay. There's also a healthy dose of snow fun activities of course.

The all-important visit to see Father Christmas is private to your family. Your children can sit and talk with him, discussing their hopes and dreams for Christmas and the year to come. There's never a dry eye amongst parents at this point!

The setting for all these wonderful experiences is breathtakingly beautiful and you will get



to share it all as a family.

Jeris is also at the heart of the Aurora Zone, so your evenings may well include time spent gazing up at an Arctic sky filled with Northern Lights.

The cosy winter cottage accommodation offers log burning stoves and a private sauna, so they are the perfect retreat and a comfortable base for your family Christmas in Lapland.

DAY 1 WELCOME TO LAPLAND

You will be greeted at Kittilä Airport and transferred directly to Jeris (around 1 hour away).

You'll then check in to your cosy winter cottage accommodation where your Arctic clothing will be waiting for you.

There may be some time for fun in the snow ahead of your welcome dinner in the restaurant this evening. The local team on reception will provide you with all the information you need for the week ahead and you can ask any questions you may have.

Throughout your stay, don't forget to keep a close eye on the sky above you at night, as this is prime Northern Lights territory!

Please note that the order and start times of the activities and meals are subject to change and this agenda should be read as a guide only.

DAY 2 SNOWSHOE SEARCH FOR THE WISHING TREE, FATHER CHRISTMAS VISIT AND CHRISTMAS CELEBRATIONS

This morning, you will head out on snowshoes in search of the magic wishing tree in the forest. Once you've located it, children will be encouraged to leave their wishes in its branches. Following this, you will be able to enjoy a warming mug of hot chocolate whilst toasting marshmallows around the campfire.

After lunch, which will be served in the hotel restaurant, it is time for the all-important event as you depart for your meeting with Father Christmas.

You will travel in a snowmobile-pulled sled which will take you to the edge of the forest.



Whilst waiting for their special meeting, guests will enjoy snacks in a kota nearby.

Then, each family will head down a candlelit, snow-covered path to a secluded cabin where you will meet the great man himself.

During your private audience with Father Christmas, he will spend time listening to the wishes of each child. There will also be plenty of opportunities for the all-important photographs to commemorate this exceptional family experience.

Following the special visit with Father Christmas, it is time to bake! Festive cookies are on the menu and the whole family can get creative. You will then be able to sample your bakes with a warm drink.

This evening, dinner will be served in the hotel restaurant and, as Christmas is primarily celebrated on the 24th in Finland, a surprise visitor may even pop in and say hello to everyone!

Following breakfast, free time this morning will give you the opportunity to enjoy some festive fun as a family – take some sleds and play in the snow, or explore your snowy surroundings.

Today's lunch will be served at nearby Torassieppi in a traditional Finnish kota.

There can be no animal which is more synonymous with Christmas in Lapland than a reindeer, so this afternoon you will spend some time in their company.

You will travel to a local reindeer farm, where a herder will tell you all about how important the animals are to this region. You can then see the furry-nosed reindeer up close and take your family photos. There will be a chance to feed them before a magical reindeer-pulled sleigh ride covering around 1km.

Included Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner



This morning will see you all take part in an unforgettable dog sled safari, a favourite with all the family. You will head to the husky centre where you will meet these working dogs and learn about their daily life. There might even be some puppies to play with which is always a treat.

You will notice that the dogs are very excited to see you all when you arrive, and they make quite a comical amount of noise as they are so excited to get on the trail. Their



enthusiasm is infectious, but as soon as they are on the move, they fall silent as they happily pull the sled along.

Adults will be given full instruction on how to handle a team of dogs and the sled before setting off in pairs (one standing on the sled and the other enjoying the view as a passenger). Children will typically all travel in a sled which is controlled by a guide. The route taken is ideal for families and covers around 6km.

After lunch, you can all enjoy the Arctic Elements Sauna World. A collection of saunas is situated on the lakeshore at Jeris, including a traditional wood-heated smoke sauna. For the very brave (healthy adults only) there is also the chance to take a dip in the ice pool – it's very refreshing!

To start the morning, you will enjoy the very Finnish, family pastime of cross-country skiing. You don't need to have tried any form of skiing before as full instruction is provided. Your guide will lead you along some of the easy trails which surround the hotel.

Kids do tend to pick this activity up remarkably quickly and go whizzing along the tracks, but it always provides some giggles for the grown-ups too. Once you have the technique, you can travel around the trails with ease and you may even fancy renting skis later in the week for some independent exploration. In total, you will be out for around 2 hours.

After lunch, it is time to explore further afield and everyone is sure to feel a rush of excitement ahead of this morning's snowmobile safari.

Snowmobiles are an integral part of life in the Arctic and you will often see families travelling together in this way to visit friends on weekends.

The adults will be given full instruction and a safety briefing before setting off in pairs for the 20km safari. The children will travel in a sleigh pulled by the guides' snowmobiles. Please note that you need a full driving licence in order to drive a snowmobile and must be over 18.

The trip will really give you the chance to appreciate the scale of the wilderness which surrounds Jeris.

Included Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

This morning you will make your way for a hearty breakfast ahead of a fun-filled day of Arctic adventures.



After breakfast, spend the morning making the most of the vast winter playground around the hotel, with plenty of fun and games in the snow. There will be ice hockey, snowshoeing and cross-country skiing and even a mini snowmobile for the children (aged between 4 and 8 depending on the size of the child). All this outdoor excitement will be fuelled with hot drinks and cookies.

Following lunch, it's time to try ice-fishing, a very traditional pastime in Lapland. Ice fishing involves drilling a hole in a frozen lake and dropping your line into the waters beneath. A guide will set you up and will be on hand with a warm drink before you settle in and await a bite on the line.

Tonight's meal will be served in Jeris' lakeside restaurant, where you will enjoy a local meal (although this is planned for tonight, the night on which you have this meal may be subject to change as is the rest of the programme).

Today has been left free for you to do as you wish. You may opt to relax and refresh before you return home tomorrow, or you could explore the local area further by hiring snowshoes or cross-country skis.

Hotel Jeris Winter Cottage (Nights: 1-6)



Winter Cottage Type A

Hotel Jeris and its winter cottages are on the shores of Lake Jerisjarvi around 20km from the nearest town. They offer families an idyllic location for a holiday in the wilds of Finnish Lapland.

The hotel consists of the main building which is home to the hotel rooms, gift shop and restaurant. The 35 winter cottages are dotted in the surrounding forests.

Hotel facilities:

- All meals are served in the main hotel restaurant. There is always a selection of options which often includes local dishes as well as more international cuisine.
- The buffet breakfast offers a wide selection of cooked and continental options; whilst lunch and dinner are usually a selection of salads, then a choice between a meat/fish main course and a vegetarian option, followed by a set dessert. During December, a special buffet menu and certain soft drinks are also provided for children.
- Tea and coffee are available free of charge throughout the day in the hotel restaurant/bar area.
- There is a small lounge area in the main building where guests can use the free Wi-Fi connection and there is a small shop selling souvenirs and snacks.
- Jeris is home to the lovely Arctic Sauna World just a short walk from the hotel. Renovated for winter 2019/20, the spa has strong eco-credentials thanks to its use of entirely renewable electricity and geothermal heating generated from the Jerisjärvi lake. Here there are four saunas each inspired by the four elements; earth, fire, water and air and named after Finnish gods and goddesses. You can also upgrade to the special Northern Lights sauna for a relaxing way to search the skies! If you are feeling brave (and are in good health) try an adventurous dip in the ice pool.

Winter Cottage Type A:

Type A winter cottages (30 square metres) are, on the whole, the closest to the hotel and are ideal for families with small children.

The cabins can vary in size but all sleep from two to four people in one spacious room with



a sleeping alcove for two people (generally with a double bed) and a pull-out sofa bed for two more. They are all privately-owned and so the décor and style can vary, but each has a cosy wood-burning stove, clothes-drying cupboard, kitchenette, television, shower room, toilet and a private sauna.

All meals are served in the hotel restaurant.

Cabin guests will receive a small 'starter pack' of firewood. Further wood supplies can be purchased locally for approximately 10 euros.

Jeris Winter Cottage Type B

Type B winter cottages (63 square metres) sleep from four to six people and are ideal for families of four or more. There is a living room area with kitchenette and wood-burning stove, one bedroom for two people and a mezzanine loft area (please note that this is accessed by a steep ladder so is not suitable for small children) which can sleep up to four more.

The cottages are all privately owned and so some contents and décor may vary, but all are equipped

with a clothes drying cupboard, sauna, TV, shower and toilet room.

The cosy winter cottages are located in the forests which surround Jeris; the furthest being across the quiet road and tucked in the trees around a 15-minute walk from the main building. Your luggage will be transferred for you on arrival.

Cabin guests will receive a small 'starter pack' of firewood. Further wood supplies can be purchased locally for approximately 10 euros.

All meals are served in the hotel restaurant.

Jeris Winter Cottage Type C





Type C winter cottages (70 square metres) are the largest available and sleep from four to seven people. There are two bedrooms (each for two people) downstairs and a loft sleeping area for a further two (or three if you don't mind being very cosy!) people accessed via a steep staircase (not suitable for small children).

As with all the cottages, there is a log-burning stove, clothes drying cupboard, kitchenette, sauna, TV, shower and toilet room. They can vary in layout a little and as they are privately-owned, the décor is determined by the owner's personal choice.

They are located in the forests which surround Jeris; the furthest being across the quiet road, and tucked in the trees between a 10 and a 20-minute walk from the main building. Your luggage will be transferred for you on arrival. All meals are served in the hotel restaurant.

Cabin guests will receive a small 'starter pack' of firewood. Further wood supplies can be purchased locally for approximately 10 euros.

Cabin B: price is based on 2 adults sharing with 2 children (minimum occupancy for a cabin B is 2 adults and 2 children or 3 adults)





Cabin C: price is based on 3 adults sharing with 2 children (minimum occupancy for a cabin C is 3 adults and 2 children or 4 adults)
