DAY 1

ARRIVAL AND TRANSFERS

You will be greeted at San Jose Airport to complete the short transfer to your hotel. En route you will be briefed about the following day's activities and in the evening you are free to relax and enjoy your new surroundings and the hotel's wonderful facilities.

DAY 2

POAS VOLCANO NATIONAL PARK AND LA PAZ WATERFALL GARDENS

After breakfast at the hotel, you will get straight down to business. Your guide will meet you at the hotel and give you an overview of the exciting day ahead before you all head to the Poas Volcano National Park. The park is home to the active Poas Volcano, cloud forest and crater lakes, so there are lots of natural spectacles to be enjoyed here and it offers an excellent introduction to Costa Rica's diverse natural world.

Next on the itinerary is a trip to La Paz Waterfall Gardens. This incredible area is a nature park and wildlife refuge, and also features some of the most famous waterfalls in Costa Rica. You will walk a 3km trail to see four of these majestic waterfalls, stopping at amazing viewpoints along the way to admire the forest. There's also a hummingbird garden, serpentarium, frog pond, small aquarium and large enclosed butterfly observatory.

Tonight a welcome meal will be served in a famous local restaurant.

Back at the hotel, you will need to repack for the next part of your journey as there is a 25lb luggage (11kg) restriction for your boat transfer tomorrow. Your luggage will be securely stored with your



guide and given back to you on Day 5.

DAY 3

RAINFOREST BOAT TRIP AND TORTUGUERO NATIONAL PARK - 'WHERE THE JUNGLE MEETS THE SEA'

Today's early start will be well rewarded and you will enjoy a traditional Costa Rican breakfast en route. Your destination is the dock, where you meet your boat for the transfer into the Tortuguero National Park (approximately three hours transfer in total including the boat trip).

Along the route, you will be able to catch a glimpse of the local wildlife and plant life that call this home. Tortuguero is one of the most biologically diverse regions in the world, offering a huge range of animals and environments to enjoy.

After lunch at your lodge, you will walk to the local town and visit a conservation centre in order to learn about the lush tropical environment in which you now find yourselves. There will also be some free time to explore or relax around the swimming pool.

This area is an extremely important location for green turtle nesting from July to September. It is possible to book a night tour directly with the lodge to hopefully observe these incredible animals. We would highly recommend this incredible experience, which is payable locally.

DAY 4

RAINFOREST EXPLORATION DAY AND WILDLIFE BOAT TRIPS

You will enjoy a full day's adventure in the rainforest today. It is an early start this morning as you set off with your guide on a tour of the canals first thing in the morning while the animals are at their most active. This is a great way to quietly sit back and quietly enjoy the unique natural habitat surrounding you.

Then it is back to the lodge for breakfast and afterwards, your guide will lead you on a rainforest hike to look at some of the scenery up close.

In the late afternoon, you will meet with your guide for another boat trip deep into the canals and waterways of the national park. You will encounter different animals and plants in their natural environment and your expert guides have an incredible ability to spot the inhabitants of the forest. These include monkeys, iguanas, sloths, herons and more. The boat used has a specially designed electrical engine, which runs very quietly allowing you to explore without disturbing any of the local wildlife.

Returning in time for dinner you will then spend your last night at Tortuguero.

DAY 5

TORTUGUERO TO RAINFOREST CAMP

This morning you will leave your lodge by boat, before travelling inland to the wonderful and lush green scenery of Sarapiquí and your Rainforest camp.

You will stop for lunch en route at a local restaurant and will arrive at your new temporary home at around 3 pm. The afternoon will be free to relax before dinner is served in the main communal tents and you will have a chance to take in your incredible jungle surroundings.

You can fall asleep in your well-equipped tented suite on the edge of the forest, listening to the sounds of nature all around you.

DAY 6

ADRENALINE DAY AND NIGHT IN THE RAINFOREST!

Today includes some really exceptional activities in some truly beautiful surroundings. The activities on the agenda include a white-water rafting trip, a horse riding trek in beautiful countryside and a thrilling canopy zip wire tour. These are exceptional family activities that highlight the environment in which they take place and provide some great family memories.

After a fantastic day in Costa Rica creating lots of wonderful memories you will return to the tented suites for another night of glamping in this beautiful jungle setting.

DAY 7

TREETOP WALK AND COMMUNITY, CULTURE AND CONSERVATION

This morning you will transfer into the shadow of the impressive and active Arenal Volcano for a guided hike (transfer around three hours). The degree of activity from the volcano varies, but at its most active there can be magnificent displays of flowing red-hot lava and incandescent rocks flying through the air.

You will visit one of the most important eco-tourism developments in the whole of the country, the Arenal Hanging Bridges. The 16 bridges are suspended within this primary rainforest and vary in length between 8 and 98 metres. The bridges allow you to get a totally different perspective on the forest, viewing the flora and fauna at close quarters as you explore this private reserve.

Following your treetop adventure, you will enjoy lunch at La Casona with a direct view of the Arenal Volcano where you will learn about the history of this 100-year-old estate. You will learn how to make the famous tortillas on the traditional woodstove before enjoying some hearty local food.

After lunch, you will visit the Eco-Centro Danaus - a small reserve that develops conservation





programmes. You will discover the natural trails and learn all about the environmental education work done here. Then you will be able to select a native tree and take it to the local elementary community school. Here, a group of children will welcome you with a folk dance before you all help with the reforestation project, planting your chosen tree.

Following a visit to the school, you will travel to the farm to meet a local family who will show you their amazing gardens. Don Aguinaldo, a member of the family will play a traditional guitar as you enjoy drinks and snacks in this wonderful setting.

You will transfer and check into your hotel. This evening you are free to either eat at the hotel or visit the nearby town for some local cuisine.

DAY 8

RAINFOREST CANYONING

Your guide will meet you at the hotel for a 30-minute drive into the rugged mountainous terrain near the volcano. The journey will be via 4x4 vehicles across some bumpy back roads to get to the start point for this thrilling canyoning adventure.

This location allows for some of the most exciting canyoning we have encountered anywhere and is based principally on thrilling rappels down beautiful waterfalls.

After full tuition, you will descend a series of six waterfalls ranging in size from 150 to 200-foot descents. A well-deserved lunch will be served back at the canyoning base.

This afternoon is free for you to either enjoy the local town or the facilities back at the hotel.

DAY 9 LAKE ARENAL STAND-UP PADDLEBOARDING AND TENORIO VOLCANIC NATIONAL PARK

Following breakfast, you'll try stand-up paddleboarding (SUP) on the stunningly-blue Lake Arenal. Admire the volcanic mountain range backdrop as you stand on top of your board and use your paddle to glide across the water.

After paddleboarding, you will explore more of Costa Rica's landscape during a visit to Tenorio Volcano National Park. The park is filled with many natural wonders but perhaps the most impressive is the Celeste River. The river gets its spectacular colour from the sulphur that is emitted by the volcanic activity and it's amazing to see how the turquoise hue contrasts with the green surrounding forests. During your visit, you can also see the four cones of the Tenorio Volcano.

Lunch is provided today and once you have explored the national park, you will be transferred to your hotel which sits amongst brilliant rainforest surroundings.

DAY 10

RIVER RAFTING ON THE TENORIO RIVER AND VISITING THE LAS PUMAS WILDLIFE RESCUE CENTRE

Today you will take on a river rafting adventure down the Tenorio River. After breakfast, you will be transferred to meet your expert river guides and will be provided with a safety talk and all the gear you need. Please note, children must be 9 years and over to take part.

You will work as a team to conquer the class III and IV rapids as you manoeuvre your way down the powerful river.

After your epic adventure on the water, you will enjoy lunch at a nearby restaurant on the banks of the Corobici River. Next, you will be taken to the Las Pumas Wildlife Rescue Centre, just minutes away.

The centre is a fantastic centre focused on protecting animals whose habitats have been destroyed by deforestation. This is a great way to learn more about some of the native wildlife in this area and the positive steps being taken to protect it. The animals here are either awaiting release back into the wild or are cared for in the sanctuary if they are unable to return to their natural habitat.

You will then be transferred to Guanacaste. The total drive time is around four hours and you will arrive with free time to relax and unwind into the last few days of your holiday.

DAYS 11 to 14

LIE BACK, RELAX AND ENJOY

The last days of your holiday are free to relax at your luxury hotel and enjoy this beautiful area following your active adventures. If you want to arrange additional activities then these can be arranged and paid for locally. Alternatively, simply enjoy the hotel swimming pool and postcard-perfect beaches.

If you'd prefer, you can choose to spend your final night in San Jose. Please enquire about this at time of booking.
