Trip Overview

Jeris provides families with the picture-perfect backdrop to their tailored pick and mix winter activity holiday. The hotel is situated on the edge of a frozen lake in the far North of Lapland and is surrounded by a pine forest, all of which are covered in snow for the wonderful winter months.

Jeris offers families a choice of two types of accommodation and you can enjoy either hotel rooms or delightful winter cottages which are dotted around the forest within 20 minutes' walk from the main building.

Not only does Jeris provide a range of accommodation but it also offers a wealth of unforgettable activities from which families can plan their ideal holiday.

There are snowmobile safaris, dog sledding adventures (for those aged 12 and over), forest forays on snowshoes, ice fishing trips, Northern Lights excursions and a host of other exceptional family experiences to choose from.

If you stay in one of the cosy cottages you'll also have access to your own private sauna each day and no matter where you stay you can enjoy the facilities down at the lakeside spa pools and sauna for an additional cost.

Simply decide when you want to travel and for how long (we recommend a minimum stay of three nights) then match your stay to the activities listed in the '[Activities](#)' tab. Please note that all accommodation and activities are subject to availability at the time of booking.

Flights, transfers, half board and cold-weather clothing for the duration of your stay are all included in your holiday.

Please note: Activity schedules are subject to change. Duration of activity includes transfer times and breaks, and all distances are approximate. Some activities require a minimum number of participants to operate and are subject to availability.

Husky safaris: Children over 15 years can usually drive a husky team themselves but this depends completely on the size of the child and their ability. The activity provider reserves the right to decide the arrangements for children according to the weather conditions and the child's ability on the day. All decisions are final and in the interest of safety. Children between 5 – 14 years of age sit in the guide's sled during safaris. We recommend only short husky safaris for young children.

Snowmobile safaris: The driver of a snowmobile must be 18 years old and hold a valid driving licence. Children will travel in a sled pulled by the guide's snowmobile on selected safaris where this is offered, older children may be able to travel as pillion on the snowmobile but this is at the discretion of the guide.

Single snowmobiles: All snowmobile safaris are based on two people sharing. If this is not possible in your party then the single snowmobile supplement will be automatically applied.

Sit back and relax as you are pulled in a sleigh, drawn by a traditional Finn Horse. As the sleigh bells jingle, you can immerse yourself in the winter wonderland of the Arctic.

Arctic Sauna World with Shaman

The newly renovated Arctic Sauna World makes for the ideal little arctic oasis if you want some time to relax during your holiday. Saunas are a huge part of Finnish tradition and culture, with the earliest records dating back to 7000BC! Finns often joke that the sauna is the first room built in any new houses and it is uncommon in Lapland to find a home without a sauna. It really is a huge way of life and a real must do during your time in

Finland.

During this activity you will learn about the history of the sauna and the traditions of how to relax and connect with nature. Arctic Sauna World was designed around the 4 elements: Tapio (the earth sauna), Ukko (fire sauna), Ilmatar (air sauna) and Vellamo (water sauna) represent the elements through our mythological gods and goddesses. A traditional local drink will be served and a shaman will make a ceremony calling on the power of the 4 elements. This programme is suitable for those aged 4 years and over.

Snowmobile with Net Fishing

After a full safety briefing with 2 people sharing each snowmobile you will depart from Jeris and head to some of the vast frozen lakes nearby. The total driving distance for the day is around 35km and you will be out between 3-4 hours. Your guide will take you to the wilderness location where the nets have been placed and show the group how to pull up the nets to retrieve the catch of the day. This is an ancient method of gathering

food during the winter time for the local people and a really interesting activity to be a part of and learn more about. During the activity lunch will be cooked over the open fire (not dependent on how successful the catch of the day is!) and you will then head back to the hotel.

Snow Train

Step inside the cosy Snow Train carriage for an Aurora hunt into the wilderness.

Pulled along by your expert guide on a snowmobile, the Snow Train has been cunningly designed with an all-Perspex exterior to give you constant views of the night sky. As you journey further into the darkness, keep your eye out for a potential display.

You'll also stop in a prime location to enjoy hot drinks and continue your search. Your location will be chosen based on the local weather and Aurora forecast for the evening, giving you the best possible chance of ticking the Northern Lights off your family's bucket list.

Northern Lights Horse-Drawn Sleigh Ride

Search for the Northern Lights from the comfort of your horse-drawn sleigh. With minimal light pollution, this is an ideal opportunity to view the Northern Lights should conditions be favourable.

Arctic Elements Lakeside Spa and smoke sauna

This may well be a favourite with the grownups as this trip is all about relaxation as you enjoy the lakeside well-being facilities.

Saunas are a traditional Finnish pastime and at Jeris, you can enjoy the wonderful lakeside surroundings as well as the different sauna experiences. The Arctic Elements Lakeside Spa is the first of its kind in Finland, with strong

eco-credentials thanks to the geothermal heating generated from the Jerisjärvi lake, 100% renewable electricity from wind, water or solar power and the shower water from the nearby under earth fountain.

The four saunas each represent the four elements; earth, air, fire and water, as these are found in all traditions and shamanic wellbeing rituals. These elements combine to create a fifth, steamy löyly, the spirit of sauna. Each element is represented by Finnish gods or goddesses, as the protectors of the saunas:

- Sauna of Tapio (Earth). Tapio is the antlered king of the forest and in this sauna, you will feel the earthy and forest surroundings of the Finnish wilderness. Created from wood, tiles and natural stone, the sauna is split into four areas, north, east, south and west, each providing a different kind of löyly from mild to hot.
- Sauna of Ukko (Fire). Ukko is the king of all gods and master of lightning, fire and air. This smoke sauna is the most traditional, and a favourite among the Finns. The wood heating

process carries the smoke throughout to create a dark colouring, smokey scent and if you choose, a fiery heat.

- Sauna of Vellamo (Water). Vellamo is the goddess of water and the ruler of lakes and rivers. This sauna has a panoramic view over Lake Jeris, a holy place for Sámi people, with its waters reflecting light onto the sauna walls it offers an incredibly calming atmosphere. The soft and moist löyly means you can stay in for longer for extended relaxation.
- Sauna of Ilmatar (Air). Ilmatar is the goddess of wind, and the first mother in the beginning of times. Made from wood and natural stone, this sauna has no fire or thick walls - instead infrared heaters are situated inside a traditional kota for a soft and gentle heat. Think of this as half sauna, half relaxation room.
- You can also choose to upgrade to the private Northern Lights sauna. Tulikettu is the mystical firefox that lights up the sky and creates the Auroras. This two-storey panorama sauna is ideally situated under the open sky with a 180-degree view over Lake Jeris. The relaxing room on the second floor has an all-sky panoramic window for a clear view of the night sky and if conditions are favourable, the Northern Lights. This sauna is perfect for private relaxation and comes with its own toilets, changing room and showers. Please ask our Family Travel Experts if you wish to include the Northern Lights sauna in your package.
- The very brave (and healthy) can also take an adventurous dip into the ice pool!

Get on the saddle

Northern Lights Horse Riding Safari

For an exciting way to search for the Northern Lights, tonight you and the family will ride on horseback through the winter wilderness. If conditions are favourable, your guide will signal the horses to stop and you'll hopefully see the Auroras dancing overhead.

This activity lasts for 1.5-2 hours including transfers and is suitable for those aged 12 years and over.



Tour to Winter Village - (40km snowmobile safari)

Today is an epic snowmobiling adventure to the Torassieppi Winter Village and Reindeer Farm. After a full safety briefing and instructions, you'll travel along trails, through wintry forests to reach your destination.

You'll visit the reindeer farm which is one of the oldest in Finland, and will have the chance to meet and feed some of the reindeer. Lunch will be served at Torassieppi, after

which you can visit the Winter Village to explore the rooms and the ice restaurant, before continuing back to Jeris on your snowmobiles.

This trip is based on two people sharing a snowmobile but if you would like to travel with your own machine this can be arranged for a supplement so please just ask our sales team for details. You will be out for a total of around 3.5 hours including lunch.

A guide will set you up and will be on hand with a warm drink before you settle in and await a bite on the line.

Lappish local culture

This is a day that always appeals to families as it includes an encounter with some of Lapland's most famous residents. You'll visit a reindeer farm where the herders will give you an insight into their lives. You'll visit a small museum and enjoy a memorable reindeer-pulled sleigh ride (2 people per sled) covering around 3km. After lunch in a traditional wooden teepee, you will explore the wonderful Torassieppi Winter Village which is next door.

Reindeer sleigh Aurora experience

This is a reindeer-pulled sleigh ride through the silent forests of Lapland (approx. 3km) and offers the chance for families with older children to catch a glimpse of the Northern Lights from a unique perspective should conditions be favourable. A warm drink and snacks will be served around a campfire. You will travel two people per sled.

Daytime panorama snowmobile safari (30km)

During this thrilling snowmobile safari, you will explore the fells and forests around Jeris. It provides a great introduction to the area and to snowmobiling. You will cover around 30km and travel with two people per machine along trails which lead you through stunning scenery; children will travel in a sled pulled by the guide's snowmobile. There will be the chance to change drivers if you both have a driving licence and are over 18.

Aurora snowmobile adventure (20km)

The chances of seeing the Aurora Borealis are enhanced on this night safari by snowmobile. After a safety briefing and instruction, you will set off on your machine travelling two people per snowmobile (children will travel in a sleigh pulled by the guide's snowmobile). Covering approximately 20km you will reach the top of a nearby fell where you will enjoy a warm drink and gaze out at the night sky. You can change drivers as long as both have

driving licences and are over 18.

Husky safari - Tour de Torassieppi (15km)

Today you'll visit the Torassieppi husky farm a short transfer from Jeris and enjoy a magical 15km sleigh ride. This is a wonderful safari for families to enjoy and gives an excellent introduction to husky safaris. You will travel two people per sled with opportunities to switch between driver and passenger.

Hotel Jeris (Nights: 1-3)



Hotel Jeris is on the shores of Lake Jerisjarvi around 20km from the nearest town, offering families an

idyllic retreat in the fell wilderness of Finnish Lapland. This remote location offers both a sense of escapism from everyday life and fantastic Northern Lights potential.

The hotel is owned and run by the Pietikäinen family who also manage the sister hotels of Harriniva, Kittila and Torassieppi. Together they make up some of our most popular accommodation options, charming families with their wonderfully fun activities and welcoming hospitality.

The hotel consists of the main building with hotel accommodation and restaurant and 32 winter cottages in the surrounding forested fells.

Hotel facilities

- All meals will be served in the newly renovated main hotel restaurant which offers families a half board buffet of traditional Finnish and international dishes. The buffet breakfast offers a wide selection of cooked and continental options; whilst dinner is usually a selection of salads followed by a choice of main course and set dessert
- There is a small lounge area where guests can use the free Wi-Fi connection and there is a small shop selling souvenirs and snacks
- Tea and coffee are available free of charge throughout the day in the hotel restaurant / bar area.
- Jeris is home to the lovely Arctic Sauna World, just a short walk from the hotel. Here there are four saunas each inspired by the four elements; earth, fire, water and air. You can also upgrade to the special Northern Lights sauna for a relaxing way to search the skies! If you are feeling brave (and are in good health) try an adventurous dip in the ice pool. The spa, renovated in 2019, is the first of its kind in Finland as it boasts strong eco-credentials thanks to the 100% renewable electricity and geothermal heat generated from the lake. Guests staying in either the cabins or the hotel rooms normally have one spa entry per holiday included. If you wish to visit more than once then this can be arranged and paid for locally with reception.

Room types

Double or twin rooms: The main hotel building at Jeris consists of 27 hotel rooms. All rooms were renovated in 2019 and offer a stylish, cosy home for your time in Lapland. The design is some of our favourite hotel rooms in Lapland and they have used local materials and designs in almost everything. These rooms have 1 double bed, a sofa bed for 1 person and the option to add in an extra bed (it will be a squeeze and we would only recommend for young children!) All rooms have en-suite bathroom with shower and have a hairdryer too.

Hotel Jeris Winter Cottage



Winter Cottage Type A

Hotel Jeris and its winter cottages are on the shores of Lake Jerisjarvi around 20km from the nearest town. They offer families an idyllic location for a holiday in the wilds of Finnish Lapland.

The hotel consists of a main building which is home to the hotel rooms, gift shop and restaurant. The 32 winter cottages are dotted in the surrounding forests.

Hotel facilities:

- All meals are served in the main hotel restaurant. There is always a selection of options which often includes local dishes as well as more international cuisine.
- The buffet breakfast offers a wide selection of cooked and continental options; whilst lunch and dinner are usually a selection of salads, then a choice between a meat/fish main course and a vegetarian option, followed by a set dessert. During December, a special buffet menu and certain soft drinks are also provided for children.
- Tea and coffee are available free of charge throughout the day in the hotel restaurant / bar area.
- There is a small lounge area in the main building where guests can use the free Wi-Fi connection and there is a small shop selling souvenirs and snacks.
- Jeris is home to the lovely Arctic Elements Lakeside Spa just a short walk from the hotel. Renovated for winter 2019/20, the spa has strong eco-credentials thanks to its use of entirely renewable electricity and geothermal heating generated from the Jerisjärvi lake. Here there are four saunas each inspired by the four elements; earth, fire, water and air and named after Finnish gods and goddesses. You can also upgrade to the special Northern Lights sauna for a relaxing way to search the skies! If you are feeling brave (and are in good health) try an adventurous dip in the ice pool.

Winter Cottage Type A:

Type A winter cottages (30 square metres) are, on the whole, the closest to the hotel and are ideal for families with small children.

The cabins can vary in size but all sleep from two to four people in one spacious room with a sleeping alcove for two people (generally with a double bed) and a pull-out sofa bed for two more. They are all privately-owned and so the décor and style can vary, but each has a cosy wood-burning stove, clothes

drying cupboard, kitchenette, television, shower room, toilet and a private sauna.

All meals are served in the hotel restaurant.

Cabin guests will receive a small 'starter pack' of firewood. Further wood supplies can be purchased locally for approximately 10 euros.

Please note: a limited number of hairdryers are available from reception.



Jeris Winter Cottage Type B

Type B winter cottages (63 square metres) sleep from four to six people and are ideal for families of four or more. There is a living room area with kitchenette and wood-burning stove, one bedroom for two people and a mezzanine loft area (please note that this is accessed by a steep ladder so is not suitable for small children) which can sleep up to four more.

The cottages are all privately owned and so some contents and décor may vary, but all are equipped with a clothes drying cupboard, sauna, TV, shower and toilet room.

The cosy winter cottages are located in the forests which surround Jeris; the furthest being across the quiet road and tucked in the trees around a 15-minute walk from the main building. Your luggage will be transferred for you on arrival.

Cabin guests will receive a small 'starter pack' of firewood. Further wood supplies can be purchased locally for approximately 10 euros.

All meals are served in the hotel restaurant.

Jeris Winter Cottage Type C



Type C winter cottages (70 square metres) are the largest available and sleep from four to seven people. There are two bedrooms (each for two people) downstairs and a loft sleeping area for a further two (or three if you don't mind being very cosy!) people accessed via a steep staircase (not suitable for small children).

As with all the cottages, there is a log-burning stove, clothes drying cupboard, kitchenette, sauna, TV, shower and toilet room. They can vary in layout a little and as they are privately-owned, the décor is determined by the owner's personal choice.

They are located in the forests which surround Jeris; the furthest being across the quiet road, and tucked in the trees between a 10 and a 20-minute walk from the main building. Your luggage will be transferred for you on arrival. All meals are served in the hotel restaurant.

Cabin guests will receive a small 'starter pack' of firewood. Further wood supplies can be purchased locally for approximately 10 euros.
