With untouched deep, powdery snow, unforgettable winter activities and situated in the very heart of Lapland, you'll be hard pushed to find anywhere as authentic, family-friendly and spectacular as Muotka for your memorable Christmas break.

Your position high above the Arctic Circle is advantageous in many ways. First, you'll have a guaranteed white Christmas - with a completely covered snowy playground to enjoy for the duration of your stay. We've included snowshoeing, a popular Finnish pastime, to help you explore the pristine environment with ease.

Your location also means you will get to meet two of the Arctic's most-loved animals; huskies and reindeer. You and the family can enjoy dog sledding across the wilderness as well experiencing a reindeer sleigh ride to really complete your Christmas break.

At night, your northerly position gives you a great chance of ticking the Northern Lights off your family bucket list. We've included a visit to a nearby Aurora camp to increase your chances as well as an Aurora alert system to help with your search. Additional Aurora activities can be added to your agenda if you have older children and wish to enjoy hunting the Aurora further, just ask one of our travel experts for a quotation.

DAY 1

ARRIVAL

Upon arrival at the airport, you will be met and transferred* to Muotka, your home for your Christmas family getaway.

Enjoy your welcome meal in the hotel restaurant and settle into your surroundings. As you are now in Northern Lights territory, you could see the magical display as soon as darkness falls. You will also be given an Aurora alert which will sound if the Northern Lights are present in the area.

*Transfers are based on a scheduled group shuttle that sometimes stops at a few nearby hotels. If you would prefer to upgrade to private taxi transfers please ask our Family Travel Experts for a quotation.

DAY 2

REINDEER DAY ON CHRISTMAS EVE

In Finland, Christmas is traditionally celebrated on the 24th and so your family festivities can begin today in true Finnish style.

After breakfast, you'll quickly get into the Christmas spirit when you visit a reindeer farm. To get there, you will travel in Arctic fashion on a snowmobile. Adults will drive the snowmobile (two per machine) while children will ride in a sled pulled by the guide's snowmobile.

You will travel further into the wilderness to reach the local reindeer farm. These animals are synonymous with Lapland and Christmas, and you'll discover their importance when you meet with local reindeer herders who will tell you all about their lives here. You will learn how to lasso the animals and enjoy a short sleigh ride, before warming up with warm snacks.



Please note you must be at least 18 years old and hold a full driving licence to drive a snowmobile.

DAY 3

HUSKY SAFARI ON CHRISTMAS DAY

Following breakfast, it's time to enjoy one of the must-do Arctic experiences; dog sledding.

You will meet with the excitable huskies who will be eager to get going along the snowy trails. Children will be tucked safely in the guide's sled and adults will ride two per sled (one driver and one passenger with the option to swap). You'll receive a full briefing and instructions on how to handle the sled before you set off into the wilds. Though the dogs are loud before you get going, you'll soon discover they fall silent when they're concentrating on the job at hand, leaving you to enjoy the wintery scenery as it unfolds around you. After the safari, there will be plenty of time to play and take pictures with your new furry friends and capture the ultimate holiday snap.

Lunch and dinner will be served in the restaurant. As today is Christmas, a special dinner will mark the occasion and you have a free evening to enjoy together as a family. Be sure to keep your Aurora alert close, as the sky could light up green to add to your festivities.

DAY 4

GENTLE SNOWSHOEING AND AURORA CAMP

Following breakfast, you and the family will strap on a pair of snowshoes and explore the winter surroundings. You will receive full instructions from your guide but essentially, the snowshoes help you walk over the deep snow without sinking. During this tour, you will follow your guide into the stunning Taiga forest to really admire the pristine beauty of the area. Your guide will point out local wildlife and tell you all about life in Finland. Enjoy lunch by the open fire before returning to the hotel. Experience tells us that children tend to take to snowshoeing like a duck to water, the parents can sometimes need a little more practise, however!

After dinner in the restaurant, it's time to hunt for the Northern Lights. You will sit in the cosy sled pulled by the guide's snowmobile and keep an eye on the sky as you travel out to a nearby camp, ideally chosen based on the weather and Aurora forecast of the evening.

Upon arrival at the camp, you will keep warm in a hut with an open fire and enjoy hot drinks as your guide tells you all about the Northern Lights, while you wait for a potential display. You will be out for approximately 2.5 hours tonight.

Today it is sadly time for your festive family adventure to come to an end. Enjoy breakfast in the restaurant before being transferred to the airport for your flight home. If you have an early flight time, we'll box up breakfast for you.

Sleep in an Aurora Kota

Muotka is renowned as an Aurora viewing destination and so the hotel has created a selection of Aurora Kotas for guests to enjoy.

These part-cabin and part-glass tepee buildings are self-contained and situated a short distance from the hotel. The idea is that you can hopefully watch the Northern Lights from the comfort of the bed.

The Kotas are all 25m² with their own private sauna, double bed and en-suite bathroom. There is also room for two extra beds for children.

Please note: prices are based on you spending the first or last night of your holiday in this unique accommodation and not keeping your original accommodation. If you would like to do this on any other night during your holiday you will need to keep your accommodation and supplements will apply. Please contact our Travel Experts for a quotation.

Muotka Wilderness Hotel (Nights: 1-4)







Around 40km away from Ivalo Airport, and tucked neatly in the forests and fells of North East Finland, families will find Muotka Wilderness Hotel.

Owned by our friends Jouko and Mari, the hotel offers the same warm welcome as its sister property at Nellim.

The landscape around the hotel is stunning and offers families an easily accessible escape from the every day.

There are two main buildings, one contains the majority of the rooms and the other houses the reception, restaurant and the remaining cosy bedrooms. They are just moments from each other so there are no long walks for meals. There are also superior sauna rooms in separate buildings and some very special cabin options too, again, only a short distance from the hotel's main restaurant. If you are considering upgrading to one of these options, subject to availability and a supplement, please speak to one of our Travel Experts.

Hotel facilities

- All meals are served in the hotel's restaurant. Typically this is a buffet of options from which to choose. There tends to be a mix of international dishes alongside some local favourites. Dietary requirements can all be catered for as long as we are informed at the time of booking.
- There is a sauna in the main building which is heated daily for guest use. Saunas are not the reserve of grown-ups in Finland and so this can be a family affair.
- Free Wi-Fi is available in the main building
- Standard rooms do not have tea and coffee making facilities but tea and coffee are available free of charge in the restaurant area

STANDARD ROOMS

All standard rooms are en-suite with shower room, wardrobe, hairdryer and nightstand and can be made up as either a double or twin. We can request adjacent rooms for you if available.

Muotka Wilderness Hotel - Superior Sauna Rooms







These sauna rooms are a great upgrade and can accommodate two adults and up to two children on extra beds. The rooms are located in separate buildings (each containing four sauna rooms) and are just a short distance from the main restaurant building. Each room is 34m^2 .

Muotka Wilderness Hotel - Panorama Log Cabins







These cosy log cabins are a wonderful treat for families. They have large glass windows on one side so you can look out across the landscape and hopefully up at the sky, where the Northern Lights often appear. The cabins are very well equipped and have an en-suite shower room, private sauna, and log burning stove.

There is a queen size bed in each and space for two extra beds for children. There is a small kitchenette and kettle provided and hairdryers are available at reception if needed.

The cabins are just a short walk from the main restaurant building and are around 50 m² in size.
